Write a summary of your research background (including specific fields, experimental work, laboratories, etc.) and how you plan to incorporate what you learn at RIKEN into your current and future research work (maximum 400 words).

(3) Presentation Abstract

Participants are obliged to give a Power Point presentation during the lecture course and also to prepare a poster presentation. All applicants must submit an abstract **(maximum 400 words)**.

3. Letter of Recommendation

A signed recommendation letter from the applicant's supervisor, addressed to the organizer must be submitted as a PDF file.

All participants will stay at the Rembrandt Inn Yokohama Tsurumi, with arrangements made by RISP. Accommodations and travel expenses will be fully covered. Round-trip plane tickets are provided with fixed arrival and departure dates; therefore participants will not be allowed any change of itinerary.
